Begun in the mid-1800's by Presbyterian missionaries, PEB has the mission of providing quality, affordable education to extremely poor and often forgotten children in the villages of Pakistan. The schools faced a major challenge in 1972 when they were nationalized, resulting in degrading facilities and substandard education for the students. In the 20+ years since the schools were released to PEB following a long period of government control, PEB has faced the daunting challenge of providing scholarships, restoring old structures and building new schools so students can achieve their full academic potential.
