

The Presbyterian Education Board of Pakistan (PEB) runs 26 schools in the Punjab region of Pakistan with almost 6,000 students in attendance. All schools are dedicated to providing quality education to all individuals regardless of race, religion or ability to pay. Since Christian and Muslim students learn together and are respected, students learn the values of tolerance, respect, and love -- which lead to a more peaceful society. Many of the students who attend PEB schools come from families living in poverty. Friends of PEB fundraises to help support PEB schools, from providing scholarships to funding building projects. Through the scholarship program, many children who could not have otherwise been able to afford school are able to get a quality education.
