OUR MISSION

To provide opportunities for the poorest of the poor children in Pakistan through cultivating U.S. support of PEB schools.

WHO IS PEB?

The Presbyterian Education Board of Pakistan (PEB) was started in the mid-1800s by Presbyterian missionaries from the United Presbyterian Church. Today they run 25 schools in the Punjab region of Pakistan. They are dedicated to providing quality education to all individuals regardless of race, religion or ability to pay.

WHO IS FRIENDS OF PEB?

Friends of PEB Inc. was formed in 2008 to support and promote the educational purposes of PEB schools and fund their development.

25 schools 500 teachers & staff 5500 students

SCHOLARSHIPS Friends of PEB operates a scholarship program to allow students to attend PEB schools who normally couldn't afford an education. To support a day student the expense is \$365 per year and a resident student is \$730 per year. A scholarship covers full tuition, books, supplies, fees and uniform. Resident students also receive room and board in one of the dormitories.

student success story JUNAID

student success story
SUMERA



Junaid is a student who attended Christian Boys' High School Martinpur. He grew up in a very poor family, with his father working as a laborer on daily wages and his mother a housemaid. He has one sister.

His parents wanted to provide an education for their children but could not afford the expenses. With heavy hearts, Junaid's parents went to the PEB school and asked if some kind of financial help could be provided. The principal offered that the children could be provided with scholarships from Friends of PEB to cover the cost of their education.

Junaid was a conscientious and hardworking student so PEB agreed to support Junaid's education and helped him to complete Pre-Engineering from Forman Christian College Lahore. Junaid scored high marks and got admission to University of Engineering and Technology (UET) Lahore. He completed his degree in Chemical Engineering because of the continuous support from Friends of PEB.

Now, Junaid is working in a multinational organization and supporting his parents. Junaid and his parents are thankful for the contribution and support of Friends of PEB for making him an independent and successful person. Junaid hopes to pass this help to other deserving students someday.



Because of the scholarships available through PEB, many young girls from underprivileged areas now have the opportunity to receive an education.

Sumera's parents worked in a brick kiln and when her mother got sick, her father took a loan from the brick kiln owner for her treatment. Sadly, her mother died and the family was left with a huge debt. Her older brother left school to work with the father in the brick kiln to help support their family.

Later, Sumera's younger brother was injured in a road accident and the family had to take another loan. One day the brick kiln owner came to Sumera's father and asked for Sumera, who was only 13 years old at the time. Her father went to a PEB boarding house and asked for shelter for Sumera, as he could not provide safety for her.

Sumera was given a scholarship and admitted to PEB's school where she completed her education. She secured good grades and later attended a nursing school. Today, Sumera is a successful staff nurse. She has cleared all of the family debts and purchased a house for her family.

Thank you for your support of Friends of PEB. Because of our faithful donors, we are able to celebrate many student success stories.








2021 BUILDING PROJECTS TOTAL RAISED \$497,890




Sangla Hill Boys Phase 1 Sargodha CGBH Phase 2 Balance
