





- Give funds to 7 building projects in 2020
- Provide 531 scholarships in 2020
- Supply 1000 + families with food during quarantine
- Keep 402 scholarship students in school during the crisis
- Help 147 students graduate in spite of the quarantine
- Supply computers needed to continue classes on Zoom
- Supplement teachers' pay so they could keep teaching
- Provide printing supplies so lesson plans could continue
- Supply each student with a water bottle
- Supply some schools with a water cooler
- Supply government required supplies and PPE
- Adapt to and apply new skills this crisis year by having visits via zoom, creating virtual trips and starting virtual
