The United Presbyterian Church of North America began its mission in the sub-continent in 1854 with evangelism, medical work and education. Mission workers in the Sialkot area (part of present day Pakistan) focused their efforts in areas where the people were extremely poor. In 1881, the Christian Training Institute was opened as a primary school and as a feeder school for Gujranwala Theological Seminary. It became the center of education for Christian boys who could otherwise not afford education. Since its founding, C.T.I has produced many key leaders who have fulfilled the school's motto which is "Light to the World". Over the years other schools were also established in different areas of the Punjab.

In the year 1972 ten (10) Presbyterian Schools were nationalized. Out of these 10 only 7 were returned in 1998 to the Presbyterian Education Board in Pakistan and 3 are still to be returned by the government. The schools returned to PEB were in a very dilapidated and deteriorated condition and needed major renovations and new constructions, even some buildings were turned into ruins due to the neglect of 26 years of government management.

In the year 1998 Mrs. Veda Shaheen Gill was appointed as the Executive Director PEB. Under her able and visionary leadership PEB took the gigantic challenge to bring these schools back to their past glory.

Today, in 2023 after 25 years of denationalization these schools, by the Grace of God and under the visionary leadership of Mrs. Veda Gill along with her bravery and untiring efforts combined with commitment and dedication of PEB team the number of PEB schools had reached to **25**. The list include **4** Higher Secondary Schools (2 yet to be returned) **13** High Schools (1 yet to be returned), **8** Village Primary Schools, 5 boarding houses, 1 orphanage and community development projects. PEB had constructed **25** new buildings which include, Schools, Boarding Houses and Multi-Purpose Halls up till now. PEB is also blessed with a new office building at 6 Empress Road, Lahore.




Vision






IJAZ RIAZ (Associate for Finance) Since 1996






KHALID MASIH (Driver) Since 2006

SHAFQAT MUNIR (Coordinator for Academics) 2005-2018






JAMES ALBERT (L) (Coordinator for Science Laboratory) 2006-2019







Unfortunately, when the schools were at their peak, the Government of Pakistan Nationalized the schools. Thus began a long period during which the schools declined. However, God answered the prayers of many and Presbyterian Education Board able to takeover these schools after a long struggle. Christian Girls' Primary School, Martinpur (now High School for Girls) was denationalized in 7 September 1998 and after four years the other well recognized school Christian Boy's High School, Martinpur was denationalized on 02 February 2002 with deteriorated buildings, no boundary wall, broken furniture and with a very small number of 60 students in this High School, where prior to nationalization the school was co-educational and at one time there were more than 800 students in the school.

My journey with PEB started right from the beginning and in this way, I am a witness of all the transformation bring in during the last 25 Years by PEB, hardworking teachers, support staff, brilliant students and last but not least Martinpur community. I also passed Matriculation from this school in 1989 when the school was under Government control. At that time my father Mr. Julian J. Nath was in Government Service and served Government Christian Boys' High School, Martinpur as a teacher from 1968 to 1998. Even my Grand Father Mr. Jacob Jagan Nath served this school as Headmaster during the period prior to nationalization. My grandfather served this school for nine years from 1934 to 1943 then he joined Government service. Therefore, I have an emotional attachment with this institution.

I joined Christian Boys' High School, Martinpur as teacher on 02 February 2002. I was being promoted as Coordinator for Academics in 2004 and in the same year being promoted as a Principal of the school. With the guidance of the profound leadership of Mrs. Veda Shaheen Gill (Executive Director) and support of many well-wishers' form all over the world, in a short span of time there was a marked difference in the physical structure as well as the academic standard of the school. The school started producing good results. In 2009 one of our students beat the 38 years old record of highest marks by achieving 82.4% marks. 



In 1998 an iron and stunning lady Mrs. Veda Javaid Gill joined the PEB as executive Director



Miss Manzoor is a shining example for any woman who would seek to lead in education.



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

KIRAN ADNAN (Teacher) 12 Years of Service



Saeeda Atma Ram (Late)

Sheila Imam Din came to Sangla Hill when she was just four years old. She said that she had no problems adjusting; because her aunties worked there, it felt just like home. She remembers Sangla Hill as a place where there was good education, discipline, a warm family-like atmosphere, and vital spiritual life. One of the aunties mentioned by Sheila was Miss Saeeda Atma Ram, who came to Sangla Hill as a first grader in 1934.

What Miss Atma Ram remembered most about the Sangla of her childhood are the beautiful and hardworking women who ran the school and hostel. There were problems, too, like snakes getting into the hostel and a shortage of handpumps when it was time to bathe or wash clothes. After finishing middle school, Miss. Atma Ram did a two-year teacher training course and returned straightway to Sangla Hill, where she served continuously for more than 48 years—first as a teacher in the middle school and then as superintendent of the hostel after she retired from teaching.

For a period in the 1970s the school and the hostel were closed down by the Board because funds had run out. During that time, Miss Atma Ram and two other ladies worked without any salary for 18 months to keep the school and hostel open. Seeing the example of their selfless dedication, the Education Board began giving small grants again.

From 1989 to 1994, I remember Miss Atma Ram's silvery hair, her smile, her gentleness, her wisdom, and her concern to see the hostel facilities at Sangla Hill renovated and made safe for another generation of girls.
