WHERE I LIVE AND LEARN

SANGLA HILL

I attend school in Sangla Hill, a city of about 150,000 people in the Punjab region of Pakistan. The city gets its name from a large hill just outside of town – a strange phenomenon since there are no other hills within a 60-mile radius of the city. There are unconfirmed stories that Alexander the Great passed through Sangla Hill during his invasions.

Our school and boarding house were established in 1902. Our campus is the largest of all of the PEB schools, and it also houses the SHE and SHA women’s empowerment projects. We are very proud of our land. We have over 7 acres of farm land where we grow wheat, rice, and seasonal vegetables to supplement meals for the boarding house girls.

Many of our parents work on farms, in the sugar mill, or as bonded labor in brick factories. Also, a lot of people here have friends or family working abroad and they send back whatever money they can.

Like so many here, I can only attend my school because someone like you provides a scholarship. Most of our parents earn very low wages and they are unable to pay for our education. Often girls are kept at home because of concerns for their safety or because they are needed to help at home. Thank you for opening the doors of education for us.
